

RESOLUTION 02-2011

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 721.15 DETERMINING THAT CERTAIN MUNICIPAL PROPERTY IS NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND HAS NO VALUE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DISCARD OR SALVAGE SAID PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Commercial Point owns certain municipal property, to wit: old steps/wooden ramp at the old municipal location; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of Commercial Point finds it to be in the best interests of the Village to discard or salvage the municipal property pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1. The Village Council hereby finds it to be in the best interest of the municipality to dispose of certain municipal property, to wit: the old steps/wooden ramp at the old municipal location ("municipal property") pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15.

SECTION 2. The Village Council furthermore hereby determines that the aforementioned municipal property is not needed for public use and that the said municipal property has no value.

SECTION 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to discard or salvage said municipal property pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
