

RESOLUTION 12-2011

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PICKAWAY COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY TO THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THE RENEWAL OF THE EXISTING FOUR (4.00) MILL TAX LEVIED FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Commercial Point, which is the taxing authority of the Village of Commercial Point, finds that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the subdivision and that it is necessary to renew the existing four (4.00) mill levy, in excess of that limitation, for current expense purposes pursuant to Section 5705.19(A) of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Council is hereby acting pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code to request the Pickaway County Auditor to certify certain information to the Village in connection with the proposed renewal of levy of four (4.00) mills.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, BY VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. The Pickaway County Auditor is hereby requested to certify to the Village the total current tax valuation of the subdivision (the Village of Commercial Point), and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a four (4.00) mill levy which renews the existing four (4.00) mills levied by the Village for current expenses. Said existing levy was approved by the voters in November, 2005 and will expire in tax year 2011.

Section 2. The proposed levy is for the current expenses of the subdivision and is a renewal of the existing four (4.00) mill levy for the purposes set forth in Section 5705.19(A) of the Revised Code.

Section 3. The amount of the proposed renewal levy tax rate is four (4.00) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, and which is a renewal of the existing tax levy for current expenses, and is to be levied for five years. The renewal levy shall be voted on at the general election to be held on November 8, 2011, and the levy shall be a levy upon the tax list and duplicate of tax year 2012.

Section 4. The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify this Resolution to the Pickaway County Auditor.

Section 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village. Emergency passage is necessary so that the Pickaway County Auditor has time to gather all requested information and submit it back to the Village Council in a time frame that would allow the proposed renewal levy to be placed on the ballot for the November, 2011 general election. Accordingly, this Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
