

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-23**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NON-DISCRIMINATORY HIRING POLICIES FOR RECIPIENTS OF CERTAIN INCENTIVES FROM THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, OHIO PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5709.832.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Commercial Point, Ohio (the "Village") wishes to provide economic development incentives to property owners from time to time to enhance the tax base of the Village and to create and retain job opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("R.C.") Section 5709.832, Village Council is required to establish non-discriminatory hiring policies for recipients of certain economic development incentives from the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, in compliance with R.C. Section 5709.832, the Village desires to pass this Ordinance to establish such non-discriminatory hiring policies;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT COUNCIL, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1. The Village hereby establishes the following non-discriminatory hiring policies for all current and future recipients of incentives from the Village pursuant to R.C. Sections 3735.67, 5709.40, 5709.41, 5709.45, 5709.62, 5709.63 and/or 5709.632: No individual may be denied employment solely on the basis of race, religion, sex, disability, color, national origin or ancestry.

Section 2. The Mayor, Finance Director, Village Administrator or any other appropriate officer of the Village is hereby directed to provide copies of the policies established in this Ordinance to each current and future recipient of the above-described incentives and to the appropriate tax incentive review councils established pursuant to R.C. Section 5709.85.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any decision making bodies of the Village that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




