

ORDINANCE 2020-09

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM OF FORTY-EIGHT (48) HOURS OF WORK PER WEEK AMONG THE TWO PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS IN THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Commercial Point has established the positions of two (2) part-time police officers within the Village of Commercial Point Police Department pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 737.16; and

WHEREAS, the needs and public safety of the Village require flexibility in scheduling the working hours of the two part-time police officers of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Village of Commercial Point Police Department has requested greater discretion in assigning the weekly schedules of the two part-time police officers within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Village Council to provide the Chief greater discretion in assigning the work schedules of the two part-time officers while maintaining the part-time status of the officers' positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Village Police Chief shall have the discretion to assign up to forty-eight (48) hours of work among the two part-time police officers within the Village of Commercial Point Police Department, subject to Section 2 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. No part-time police officer shall be scheduled to work more than thirty-nine (39) hours in any single week.

SECTION 3. All prior legislation inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that result in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the earliest date allowed by law.
