

ORDINANCE 2021-08

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM YEARLY HOURS FOR THE POSITION OF CAPTAIN WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT POLICE DEPARTMENT AT 1,040 HOURS PER YEAR, AND AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 2020-08.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 737.16 authorizes the legislative authority of a village to establish positions within the village's police department; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council established the position of part-time Captain within the Village of Commercial Point Police Department by the enactment of Ordinance 2020-08, which was passed on June 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2020-08 established the Captain's maximum hours per week at twenty (20) hours; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to provide the Police Chief greater flexibility and discretion in scheduling hours for the Captain's position, while maintaining the part-time nature of the Captain position, by giving the Police Chief the ability to schedule the Captain's hours on a yearly, rather than weekly, basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The position of Captain within the Village of Commercial Point Police Department shall be a position that is compensated at no more than 1,040 hours per year.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Ordinance 2020-08 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. The position of Captain shall be part-time and compensated at no more than ~~twenty (20) hours per week~~ 1,040 hours per year. The Captain's hours shall be scheduled at the discretion of the Police Chief, except that the person holding the Captain's position shall, in no case, be scheduled for more than thirty-nine (39) hours of work per week.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
