

RESOLUTION 42-2016

A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER MONIES WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND FROM THE PERSONNEL SERVICES PART TIME OFFICER ACCOUNT 1000-110-190-1013 AND TRANSFER SAID MONIES TO THE PERSONNEL SERVICES FULL TIME OFFICER ACCOUNT 1000-110-190-1015.

WHEREAS, Council is authorized to create, appropriate, and transfer funds within the General Fund of the Village of Commercial Point; and

WHEREAS, Council has agreed to include overtime wages for our full time officers; and

WHEREAS, monies appropriated to the Personnel Services Part Time Officer Account were more than needed; and

WHEREAS, monies appropriated to the Personnel Services Full Time Officer Account were less than needed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. Monies in the amount of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$2,800.00) shall hereby be transferred within the General Fund of the Village of Commercial Point from Account Number 1000-110-190-1013 Personnel Services Part Time Officer Account to Account Number 1000-110-190-1015 Personnel Services Full Time Officer Account.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Commercial Point which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.


