

**RESOLUTION 12-2018**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE  
VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT TO PROCLAIM SEPTEMBER 2018  
“PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH”**

**WHEREAS**, this year approximately 164,690 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in the United States alone; and

**WHEREAS**, in Ohio an estimated 5,810 new cases of prostate cancer will be diagnosed with an estimated 1,100 deaths occurring in 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, men with relatives - father, brother, son – with a history of prostate cancer are twice as likely to develop the disease; and

**WHEREAS**, education regarding prostate cancer and early detection strategies is critical to saving lives, preserving, and protecting our families; and

**WHEREAS**, if caught early, prostate has a five-year survival rate of nearly 100%; and

**WHEREAS**, all men are at risk for prostate cancer and we encourage the citizens of the Village of Commercial Point to increase the importance of prostate screenings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor is authorized to sign a proclamation on behalf of the Village.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Commercial Point, Pickaway County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The Council of the Village of Commercial Point hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor to proclaim September 2018, “Prostate Cancer Awareness Month.”

**SECTION 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.






