

RESOLUTION 20-2018

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 721.15D DETERMINING THAT CERTAIN MUNICIPAL PROPERTY, IE, (1) 2012 CHEVROLET IMPALA, IS NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND HAS A VALUE OVER ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO DISCARD BELOW SAID MOTOR VEHICLE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Commercial Point owns certain municipal property, to wit: (1) 2012 Chevrolet Impala, VIN #2G1WD5E38C1177119; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of Commercial Point finds it to be in the best interests of the Village to hold an internet auction to discard the municipal property pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15D; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Commercial Point will hold an internet auction on www.govdeals.com; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Commercial Point will administer the auction and permit it to be bid on for ten (10) calendar days; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Commercial Point will require certain terms of sale, IE, offer this vehicle to be auctioned on an "as-is" basis;. Buyer hereby agrees to pay with a certified bank check or other certified electronic means; buyer will pay all applicable sales and/or use tax; buyer agrees to pick up stated vehicle in person or arrange for and pay for shipping; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Commercial Point hereby designates Fiscal Officer Hastings to be the representative for the sale. Contact address is 10 W. Scioto Street, Commercial Point, Ohio, 43116 with contact number 614-877-9248.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, COUNTY OF PICKAWAY, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1. The Village Council hereby finds it to be in the best interest of the municipality to dispose of certain municipal property, to wit: (1) 2012 Chevrolet Impala pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15D.

SECTION 2. The Village Council furthermore hereby determines that the aforementioned municipal property is not needed for public use and that the said municipal property has a value over one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).

SECTION 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to discard by internet auction said municipal property pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15D.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.


