

**RESOLUTION 30-2020**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT'S SHARE OF FUNDS FROM THE PICKAWAY COUNTY CORONAVIRUS RELIEF DISTRIBUTION FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in H.B. 481 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly (H.B. 481); and

**WHEREAS**, H.B. 481 requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 27 of the act, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described Section 601(d) of the CARES Act, and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Commercial Point is requesting its share of funds from the Pickaway County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, OHIO THAT:**

**Section 1.** The Village of Commercial Point affirms that all funds received from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund pursuant to H.B. 481 be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in Section 601(d) of the CARES Act, and any applicable regulations and guidance only to cover expenses that:

- A. Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- B. Were not accounted for in the Village of Commercial Point's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- C. Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020.

**Section 2.** In compliance with H.B. 481, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Commercial Point that the Fiscal Officer take all necessary action to:

- A. On or before October 15, 2020, pay any unencumbered balance of money in the Village of Commercial Point's local coronavirus relief fund to the Pickaway County Treasurer;
- B. On or before December 28, 2020, pay the balance of any money in the Village of Commercial Point's local coronavirus relief fund to the state treasury in the manner prescribed by the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management; and
- C. Provide any information related to any payments received under H.B. 481 to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management as requested.

**Section 3.** This Resolution is deemed to be an emergency because the Resolution must be certified to the County Auditor in order for funds to be distributed, and shall, therefore, go into effect immediately upon passage for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.


