

RESOLUTION 31-2020

A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND WITHIN THE 2020 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS BUDGET FOR THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136 (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in H.B. 481 of the 133rd General Assembly (H.B. 481); and

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution 30-2020 on September 14, 2020 requesting the Village of Commercial Point's share of funds from the Pickaway County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Commercial Point is required to deposit and distribute all monies received from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) in accordance with the procedure described in Section 27 of H.B. 481; and

WHEREAS, the Village must, pursuant to H.B. 481, establish a special fund to be named the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund to receive its share of monies from the Pickaway County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund;

WHEREAS, no dedicated fund for the purpose of receiving and distributing monies from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act currently exists within the 2020 appropriations budget for the Village of Commercial Point.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Commercial Point shall create a Local Coronavirus Relief Fund, as described by Section 27(E) of H.B. 481, within the 2020 permanent appropriations budget.

Section 2. The Village of Commercial Point affirms that all funds received from the Pickaway County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund pursuant to H.B. 481 shall be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requires of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance only to cover expenses that: (a) are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19); (b) were not accounted for in the Village of Commercial Point's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and (c) were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30,2020.

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Commercial Point shall use the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund to deposit and distribute all monies received from the Pickaway County Coronavirus Relief Distribution funds in accordance with the guidelines of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d) and any applicable requirements in H.B. 481.

Section 4. Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency for the reason that monies will be received from the Pickaway County Coronavirus Relief Distribution funds in the next 7 days and will need to be appropriated before October 15, 2020 and used by December 31, 2020. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into immediate effect upon passage as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Commercial Point.


