

RESOLUTION 42-2020

A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER MONIES WITHIN THE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FUND FROM THE OTHER – SALARIES-ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF CONSTRUCTION MANAGER 2901-710-139-1025 AND TRANSFER SAID MONIES TO THE OTHER - SALARIES – ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF ENGINEER ACCOUNT 2901-710-139-1020.

WHEREAS, Council is authorized to create, appropriate, and transfer funds within the Housing Development Fund of the Village of Commercial Point; and

WHEREAS, monies appropriated to the Other Salaries Administrative Staff Construction Manager Account were more than needed; and

WHEREAS, monies appropriated to the Other Salaries Administrative Staff Engineer were less than needed to finish out payroll for the remainder of 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Monies in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) shall hereby be transferred within the Housing Development Fund of the Village of Commercial Point from Account Number 2901-710-139-1025 Other Salaries Administrative Staff Construction Manager Account to Account Number 2901-710-139-1020 Other Salaries Administrative Staff Engineer Account.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Commercial Point which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
