

RESOLUTION 23-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE PICKAWAY COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND/OR INDIVIDUAL SPECIAL DUTY SHERIFF DEPUTIES FOR TEMPORARY LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PUBLIC SAFETY COVERAGE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT FROM JULY 17, 2021 THROUGH JULY 25, 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Commercial Point Police Department has recently experienced several long-term and short-term vacancies for various reasons; and

WHEREAS, from July 17, 2021 through July 25, 2021, the Police Department will lack adequate resources to provide law enforcement and public safety coverage within the Village of Commercial Point on a twenty-four hour basis; and

WHEREAS, the Pickaway County Sheriff's Office has offered to provide the Village of Commercial Point with sufficient special duty deputy sheriffs to allow the Village of Commercial Point to provide temporary law enforcement and public safety coverage within the Village on a twenty-four basis during the period of July 17, 2021 through July 25, 2021; and

WHEREAS, compensation for the special duty deputy sheriffs will be at a reduced rate available to non-profit and public entities; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of hiring the special duty deputy sheriffs is no more than \$3,000 for the period of July 17, 2021 through July 25, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to authorize and direct the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Pickaway County Sheriff's Department for temporary law enforcement and public safety coverage within the Village of Commercial Point from July 17, 2021 through July 25, 2021 to ensure that the residents of the Village have twenty-four hour law enforcement and public safety coverage during that period of time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Pickaway County Sheriff's Department for temporary law enforcement and public safety coverage within the Village of Commercial Point from July 17, 2021 through July 25, 2021 to provide twenty-four coverage within the Village by special duty deputy sheriffs at the public rate offered by the Sheriff's Department in accordance with the terms described in Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Village Council hereby ratifies the use of special duty deputy sheriffs from the period of July 17, 2021 through the enactment of this Resolution.

Section 3. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to issue payment to each individual special duty deputy sheriff who performs services on behalf of the Village of Commercial Point from July 17, 2021 through July 25, 2021 for the costs of each deputy sheriff's hourly rate. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to issue payment to the Pickaway County Sheriff's Department for the usage of the Sheriff's Department cruisers from July 17, 2021 through July 25, 2021.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. Because the Village of Commercial Point needs immediate law enforcement and public safety coverage on a twenty-four hour basis, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare within the Village of Commercial Point and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect upon passage.
