

RESOLUTION 30-2022

A RESOLUTION OBJECTING TO THE LIQUOR PERMIT APPLICATION OF 3505 PARSONS AVE. LTD DBA MO'S PLACE (PERMIT NUMBER 89150180005), REQUESTING A HEARING WITH THE OHIO DIVISION OF LIQUOR CONTROL, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS TO CARRY OUT SUCH OBJECTION AND REQUEST.

WHEREAS, 3505 Parsons Ave. LTD DBA Mo's Place ("Mo's Place") has submitted a liquor permit application to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control for a D-1 and D-2 liquor permit for its establishment at 22 East Scioto Street, Commercial Point, Ohio 43116; and

WHEREAS, the building in which Mo's Place is located also contains a daycare and a pre-school, which are within five hundred (500) feet of Mo's Place; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has obtained an extension from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control to object to the liquor permit application of Mo's Place and to request a hearing by no later than September 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to object to the liquor permit application of Mo's Place and request a hearing with the Ohio Division of Liquor Control at the Division's offices in Reynoldsburg, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Objection to Liquor Permit Application of 3505 Parsons Ave. LTD DBA Mo's Place and Request for a Hearing with the Ohio Division of Liquor Control.

(A) The Village Council of the Village of Commercial Point hereby objects to the liquor permit application of 3505 Parsons Ave. LTD DBA Mo's Place (Permit Number 89150180005), as described in the Notice from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, for the reasons that that (1) the place for which the permit is sought is so located with respect to the neighborhood that substantial interference with public decency, sobriety, peace, or good order would result from the issuance of the permit and operation under it by the applicant; and (2) the place for which the permit is sought is so situated with respect to a school such that the operation of the liquor establishment will substantially and adversely affect or interfere with the normal, orderly conduct of the affairs of those facilities or institutions.

(B) The Village Council hereby requests a hearing on said liquor permit application to be held at the offices of the Ohio Division of Liquor Control at 6606 Tussing Road, Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068.

Section 2. Authorization and Direction to Village Solicitor. The Village Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Division of Liquor Control and take whatever actions are necessary to carry this Resolution into effect.

Section 3. Open Meetings Certification. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Administrative Resolution shall go into effect and be in force from the earliest date allowed by law.



 - Any requests for a one-time, 30-day extension will be reviewed by the Division upon timely receipt. If granted, your additional 30-days runs from the expiration of the original 30-day period.
