

RESOLUTION 36-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER TO EXPEND UP TO \$500.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A LOUD SPEAKER SYSTEM FROM ACCOUNT NUMBER 2041-320-590 (PARKS AND REC - CAPITAL OUTLAY) TO BE USED IN CONNECTION WITH VILLAGE PARKS AND RECREATION EVENTS.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of a municipal corporation may expend public moneys for any public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has authorized the use of Village property for farmers' markets and food truck festivals and other events under the jurisdiction of the Parks and Recreation Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to authorize the purchase of a loud speaker system to be used in connection with Parks and Recreation events within the Village of Commercial Point (including, but not limited to, farmers' markets, food truck festivals, and movie nights), which the Village Council finds to be for a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Authorization to Village Fiscal Officer to Expend up to \$500.00 from Account Number 2041-320-590 (Parks and Rec - Capital Outlay) for the Purchase of a Loud Speaker System for Use in Connection with Parks and Recreation Events in the Village. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to expend up to five hundred dollars and 00/100 cents (\$500.00) for the purchase of a loud speaker system to be used in connection with Parks and Recreation events (including, but not limited to, food truck festivals, farmers' markets, and movie nights) within the Village from Account Number 2041-320-590 (Parks and Rec - Capital Outlay).

Section 2. Declaration of Public Purpose. The Village Council hereby finds and determines that the expenditure of moneys described in Section 1 of this Resolution is for a public purpose.

Section 3. Open Meetings Certification. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
