

**RESOLUTION 46-2022**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND CHIEF OF POLICE TO DONATE SEVEN (7) OBSOLETE TASERS TO ANOTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY, LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING FACILITY, OR EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION WITH A LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Commercial Point is authorized to discard municipal personal property that is not needed for public use, or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired if the Village Council determines that the municipal personal property has no value pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(C); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Commercial Point acquired seven (7) TASER-brand conducted electric weapons for use in the Police Department several years ago, with Serial Numbers X00-514189, X00-565431, X29005AP9, X29004EK1, X29004CWA, X3000CT5Y, and X30006M5C, along with holsters and other miscellaneous implements, and which are now obsolete ("Obsolete TASERs"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Obsolete TASERs are no longer suitable for use by the Village of Commercial Point Police Department and are no longer needed for public use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Obsolete TASERs no longer have any value; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council desires to donate the Obsolete TASERs to another governmental agency, law enforcement training facility, or educational institution with a law enforcement training program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COMMERCIAL POINT, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**Section 1. Declaration that Obsolete TASERs are Not Needed for Public Use.** The Village Council hereby finds that the Obsolete TASERs are not needed for public use by the Village and are obsolete for the purpose for which they were acquired.

**Section 2. Declaration that the Obsolete TASERs Have No Value.** The Village Council hereby finds that the Obsolete TASERs have no value.

**Section 3. Authorization and Direction to Donate Obsolete TASERs and Restriction on Use of TASER X29004CWA.** The Mayor and Chief of Police are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary actions to effect the donation and transfer of the Obsolete TASERs to another governmental agency, law enforcement training facility, or educational institution with a law enforcement training program for use by said agency, facility, or educational institution. The TASER device with Serial Number X29004CWA shall be used for training or target practice purposes only.

**Section 4. Open Meetings Certification.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.


